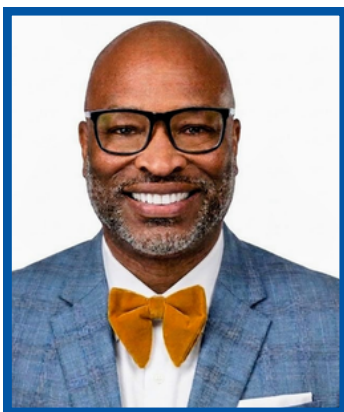




SEAN A. FISHER, SR.
